- ▶ West Virginia Health Right, Inc. (dental trailer, truck, dental hygienist, dental assistant, truck driver, equipment, supplies, repair and maintenance, gas, etc.)
- ▶ Marshall University (Faculty Dentist/Resident)
- ▶ Host sites (referrals of patients, assistance with care coordination, potential integrations of medical/dental homes, place to park, electrical power, internet access)
- ▶ Funding from multiple foundations/grant sources
- ▶ Leveraged resources (Volunteer Dentists and other staffing, students from local Dental Hygiene schools)

Unit travels to Boone, Clay, Harrison, Logan, McDowell, & Roane Counties

- ▶ Community Partners in each location:
 1. Welch Community Hospital (McDowell)
 2. Boone Memorial Hospital (Boone)
 3. Coalfield Health Center (Logan)
 4. Health Access (Harrison)
 5. Roane General Hospital (Roane)
 6. Community Care of WV (Clay)
- ▶ Visit each location 2-4 times a month (on the road 4 days/wk)
- ▶ Just under 3,000 adults served in first year (850K+)
- ▶ Year 2: Estimate to see 4,000 adults (worth over 1.2 million)
